Phonics
 Using the scheme, Supersonic Phonic Friends, I will learn:
 Reception: ai, ee, igh, oa, oo,oo, ar, or, ur, ow, oi, er, ure, ear and air.
 I will use my phonic knowledge in my writing and my reading.
 Nursery: I will continue with Phase 1 as well as learning phonemes s,a,t,p,i and n.



Cooking
 I will make carrot cake, vegetable soup and pancakes whilst using peeling tools safely.

PE
 In the hall, I will use a range of equipment to practice balancing on both apparatus and on the floor. I will practice my jumping and rolling skills on the floor and using apparatus.

English
 Reception: I will continue to use my phonic knowledge to write in sentences using finger spaces and full stops, writing from the left to the right. I will then re-read my work to make sure it makes sense. I will form most of my letters correctly.
 Nursery: I will continue to mark make, I will practice writing my name and start to form recognisable letters.
Reading
 Reception: I will continue to take home two books, one decodable phonics book and a reading for pleasure book.
 Nursery: I will continue taking books home to share with my grown ups and foster a love of reading.

 I will make a waterproof shelter for Peter Rabbit.
 I will make a wormery.
