### Reception Baseline Assessment (RBA)

The reception baseline assessment (RBA) is a short, interactive and practical assessment of your child's early literacy, communication, language and mathematics skills when they begin in school. It will be undertaken with your child's class teacher, Mrs. Tebay and it will measure your child's progress from Reception to Year 6. When your child reaches Year 6, you will be able to see the progress your child has made throughout their school journey.
