

Appendix 1: Instrument of Government

CUMBRIA COUNTY COUNCIL INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT

1. The name of the school is **Allithwaite Church of England School**.
2. The school is a voluntary controlled school.
3. The name of the governing body is "**The governing body of Allithwaite Church of England School**".
4. The governing body shall consist of:
 - a. 2 parent governors
 - b. 1 LA governor
 - c. 1 staff governor
 - d. 1 headteacher
 - e. 3 foundation governors
 - f. 4 co-opted governors
5. Total number of governors 12.
6. The term of office for all categories of governors is 4 years.
7. Foundation Governors are appointed by the Diocesan Board of Education after consulting the PCC of the ecclesiastical parish in which the school is situated.
8.
 - (a) the holder of the following office shall be a foundation governor ex officio:

The Principal Officiating Minister of the ecclesiastical parish in which the school is situated.
 - (b) The Archdeacon of the Archdeaconry in which the school is situated shall appoint a foundation governor to act in the place of the ex-officio foundation governor whose governorship derives from the office named in (a) above, in the event that the ex-officio foundation governor is unable to act as a foundation governor, or has been removed from office under regulation 21(1) of the Regulations.
9. The Archdeacon of the Archdeaconry in which the school is situated shall be entitled to request the removal of any ex-officio foundation governor and to appoint any substitute governor.
10. A Trust exists for the school.
11. Recognising its historic foundation, Allithwaite CE Primary School will preserve and develop its religious character in accordance with the principles of the Church of

England and in partnership with the Church at parish and diocesan level.

Allithwaite CE Primary School aims to serve its community by providing an education of the highest quality with the context of Christian belief and practice. It encourages an understanding of the meaning and significance of faith, and promotes Christian values through the experience it offers to all its pupils.

12. This instrument of government comes into effect on 10 July 2019.
